

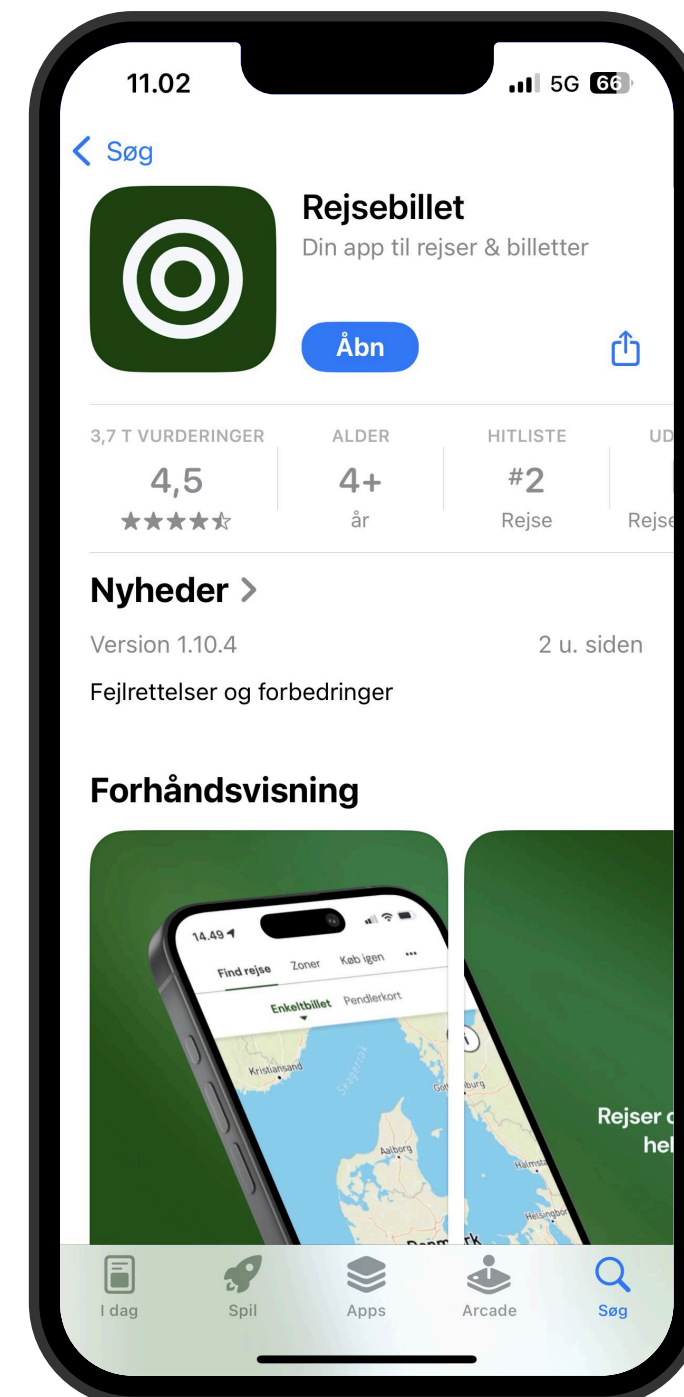
Guide to Commute20

To buy and use Commute20, simply follow this guide.

First, download Rejsebillet on your phone and create your profile.

REMEMBER: Commute20 is only available for the DOT area – that is, Zealand, Lolland, Falster, and Møn.

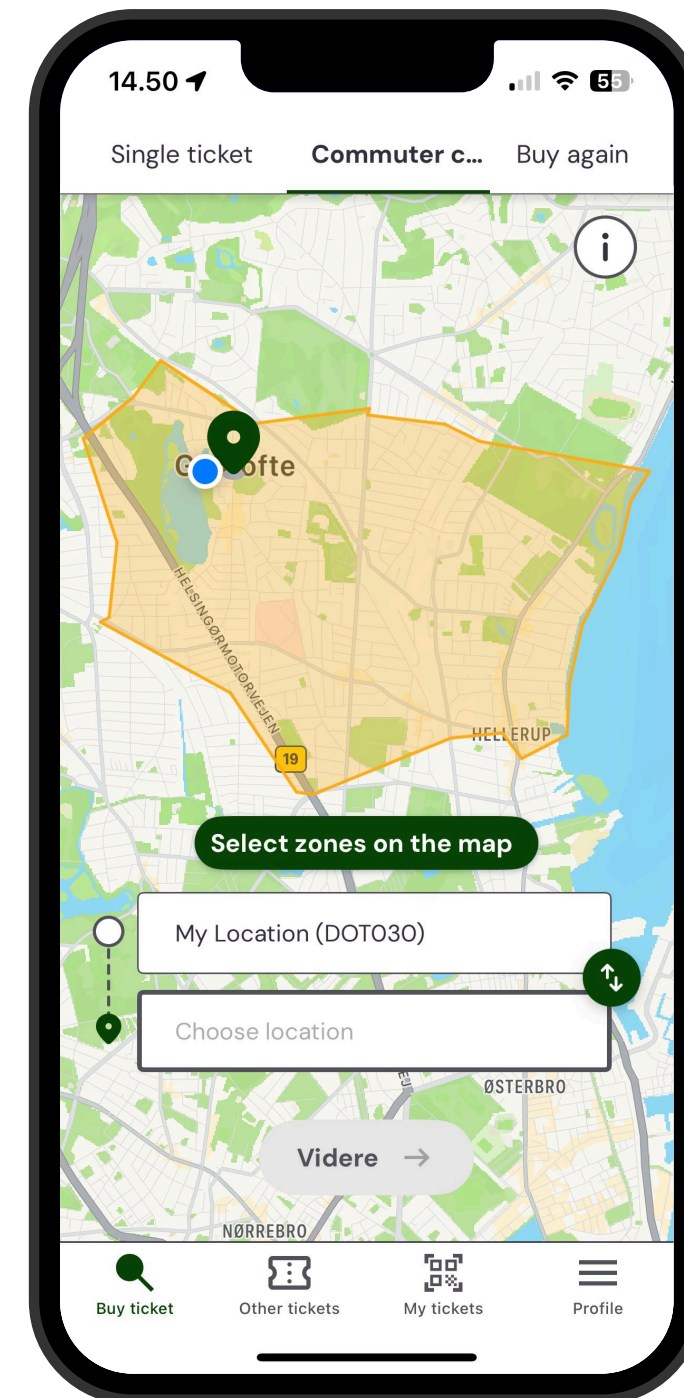
- 1 Create your profile in the Rejsebillet app
- 2 Click on Commuter card
- 3 Buy Commute20 and activate traveling days



Download Rejsebillet in App Store or Google Play Store

If you don't already have a profile, you'll need to create one in Rejsebillet first.

Then, click on Commuter card at the top centre of the screen.



Choose Commuter card

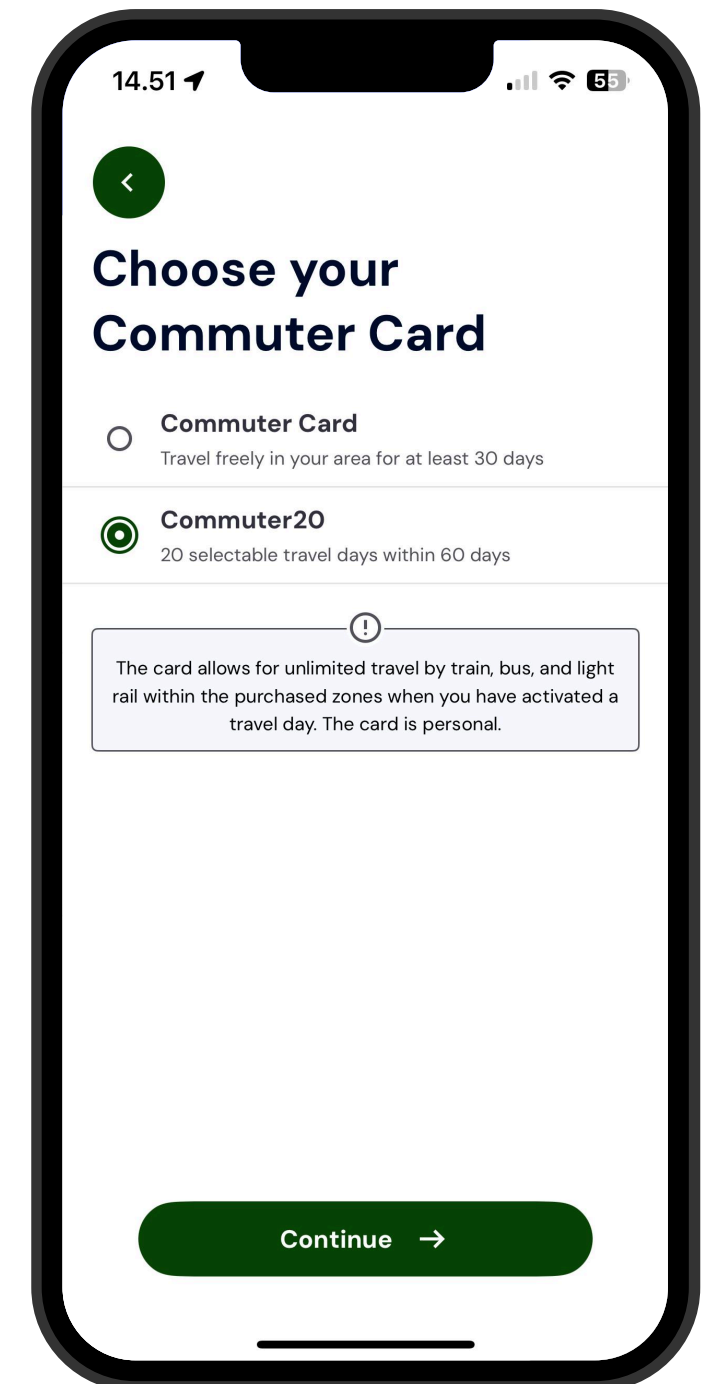
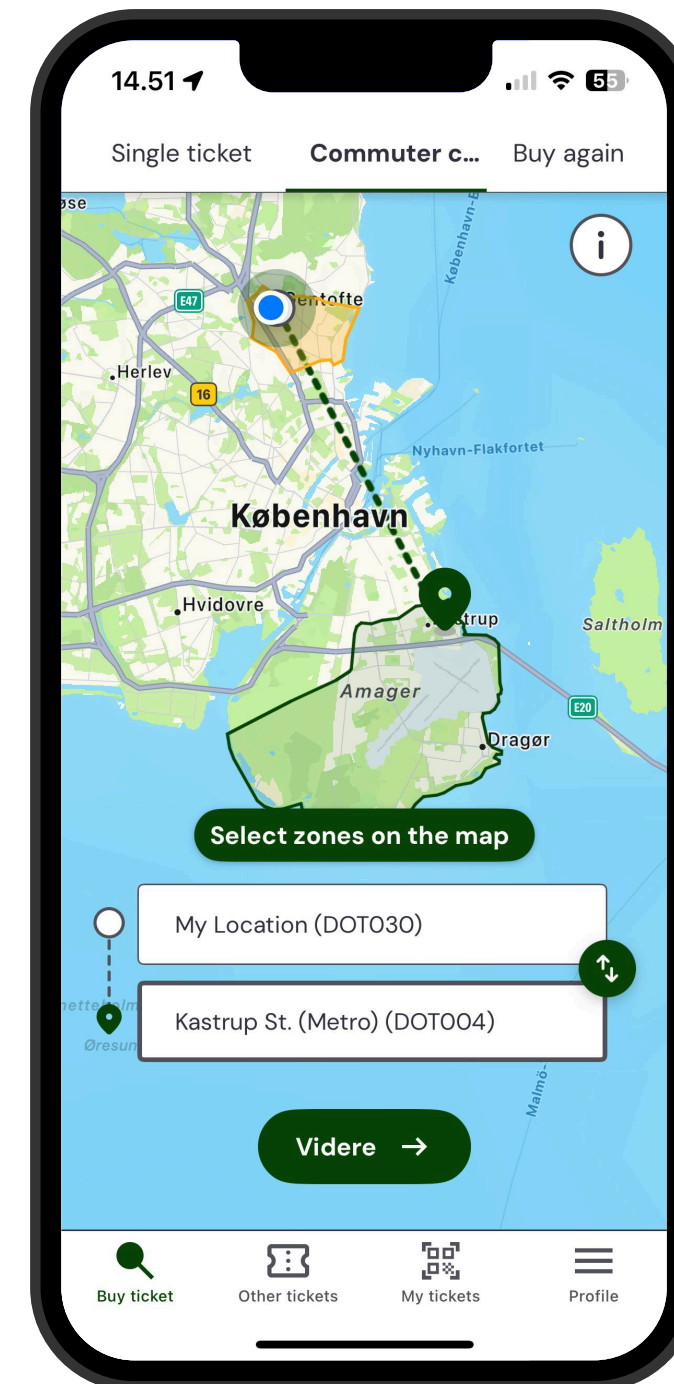
Enter your regular route or select the area on the map that you want your Commute20 to cover.

You can do this by:

- Entering the place you want to travel from and the place you want to travel to
- Selecting the zones you want to travel in

Click Continue

Select Commute20 and then click Continue.



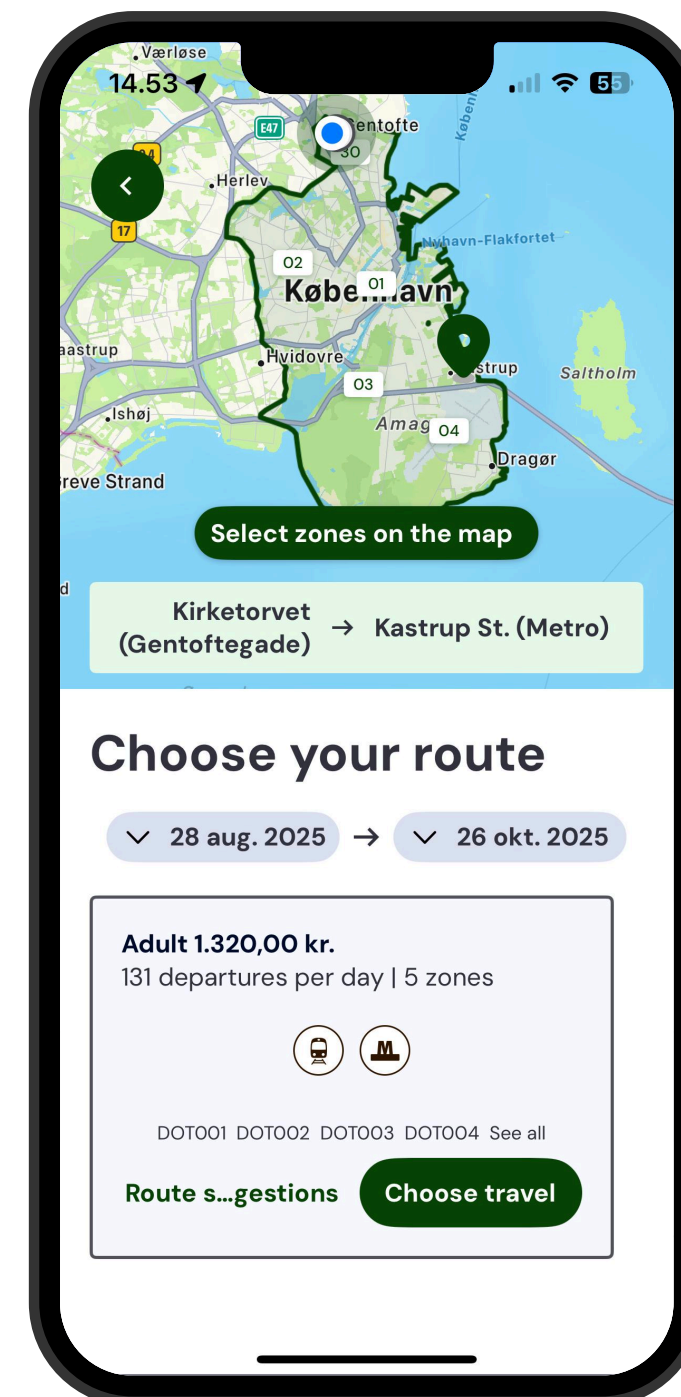
Choose your route

Choose the start date for your Commute20. You can change the date by clicking the downward arrow in the grey date field.

Next, select the route that best matches your travel needs.

You'll be able to see the price and which zones the route covers before making your choice.

Click on the route suggestion that suits you best, and then select Choose journey.



Configure Commuter card

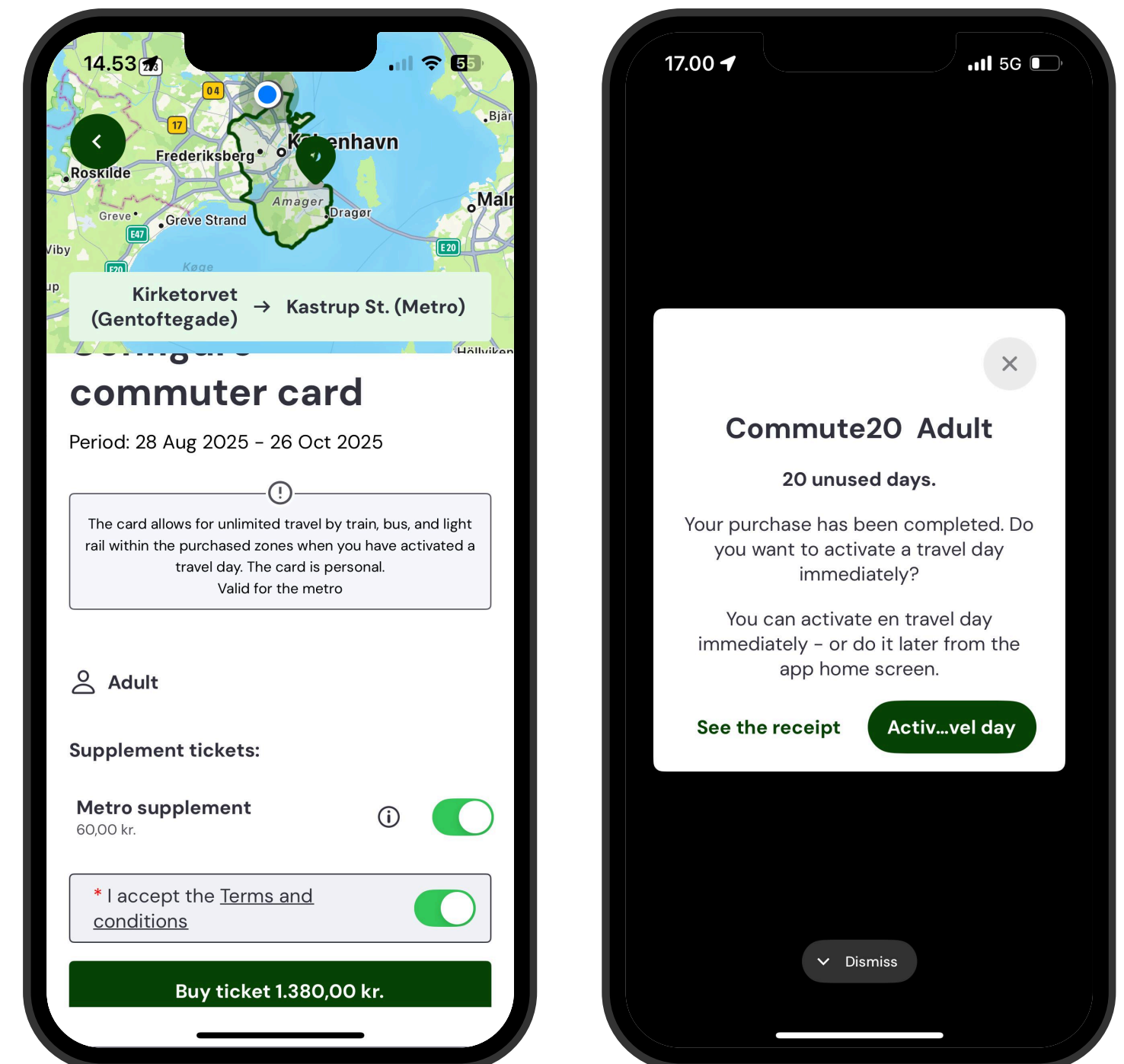
You now need to choose whether you want metro access automatically included in your Commute20. This will already be selected if you've chosen a route that includes the metro.

If you deselect Metro supplement but later wish to travel by metro, you can buy a single-zone Supplement ticket for commuters.

If you'd like to travel with DSB 1', simply click the box to the right of the line until the circle turns green.

Accept the terms and conditions, then click Buy ticket at the bottom of the screen.

Once you've clicked Buy ticket, you'll immediately receive confirmation that you now have 20 travel days to use within the following 60 consecutive days.



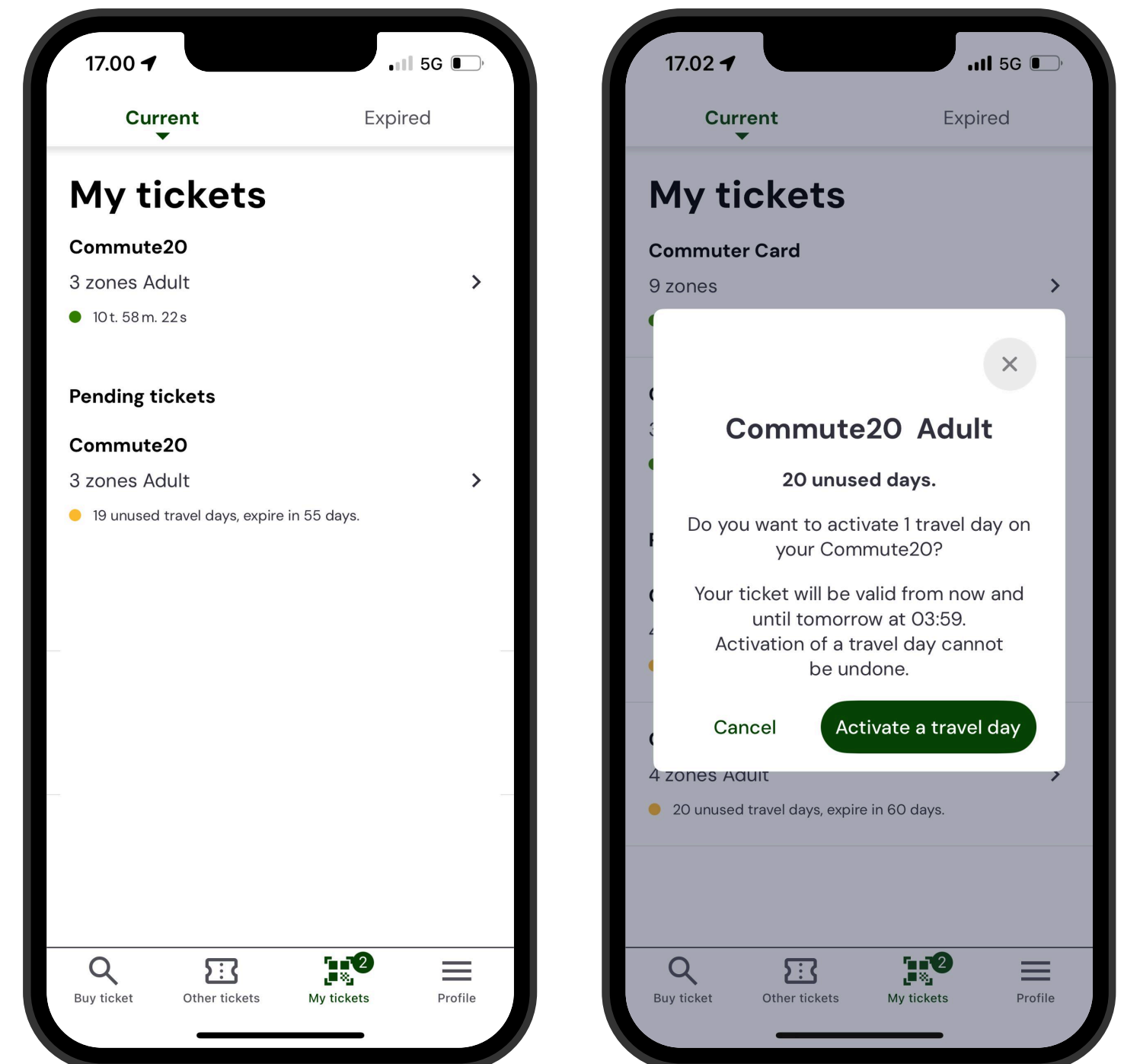
How to use Commute20

To use a travel day, you need to activate it under My tickets at the bottom of the screen.

Here, your Commute20 will appear as activated and pending.

Click the arrow on the right to activate a travel day. Please note that the ticket will be valid immediately and remain valid until 03:59 the following morning.

Activation cannot be undone, so only activate when you're ready to travel.



Your ticket on Commute20

Once you've activated a travel day, you can view your ticket under My tickets by clicking on the activated ticket.

This is also where you show your ticket in case of inspection.
